
## Present Continuous con significato di futuro

- Può essere accompagnato da una data, un orario o da un'espressione di tempo come tomorrow, next week, tonight, in an hour (vedi sopra).
- In italiano lo traduco di solito con il presente indicativo oppure "dovere + infinito".
- es. I'm leaving at 11 a.m. tomorrow.
   (parto alle 11 domani / devo partire alle 11 domani)
